
ADR 1.3 Awareness

Target Audience

Terminal workers (road) and drivers (up to the limits of LQ)

Course Objectives

Gain the competencies required to properly identify and handle shipments containing dangerous goods for road transport according to the current edition of the ADR Dangerous Goods Regulations. Understand the legal responsibilities involved with the transportation of dangerous goods.

Course Description

- This course will be presented with the use of handouts, slides, video's, practical exercises, group discussions and games.
- The course will finish with an open-book examination.

Prerequisites

- No previous DG knowledge is necessary as this course is suitable for beginners
- The ADR manual is available in local languages.
- The classroom facilitation can be given in English, Danish or Swedish.

Duration

4 hours

Learning Outcomes

- **General philosophy. What is ADR?**
- **Classification:** What different kinds of DG are there?
- **Marking/Labelling:** How do I recognize DG packages?
- **Handling:** Storage and loading procedures
- **Comply with ADR** for loading and dispatching of DG
- **Emergency procedures**
- **Hidden dangerous goods**
- **Security Provision**

Certificate and further training
