## **Live Animals Awareness (AVI)**

### **Target Audience**

Air cargo terminal staff, shippers and authorities that handle air shipments of live animals.

### **Course Objectives**

- Gain the competencies required to properly identify and handle shipments containing live animals for air transport according to the current edition of the IATA Live Animals Regulations (LAR) manual.
- Understand the legal responsibilities involved with the transportation of Live Animals.

### **Course Description**

- This course will be presented with the use of handouts, slides, video's, practical exercises, group discussions and games.
- The course will finish with an open-book examination.

### **Prerequisites**

- This course is suitable for people with no prior knowledge.
- The IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations and all course materials are presented in English.
- The classroom facilitation can be given in English, Danish or Swedish.

### **Duration**

1 Days (8 hours)

### **Learning Outcomes**

- **Applicability:** Legal aspects of transport of Live Animals
- **CITES:** How to identify what animals are endangered according to CITES
- **Animal Kingdom:** Taxonomy and classification
- **Documentation:** What documents are required
- **Container Requirements:** "Packing Instructions" for animals
- **Marking & Labelling**
- **Handling:** Storage and loading procedures
- **Emergency procedures**
- **Hidden dangerous goods**
- **Security Provision**

### **Certificate and further training**

A certificate is awarded upon successful completion of the course and scoring a minimum of 80% in the final exam.

In order to keep this certificate validated, recurrent training must be provided within 24 months of the previous course. This also ensures knowledge is up-to-date.
