
DG SafetyGroup Complete Cargo Awareness Course

Target Audience

Air cargo terminal staff that handle air and road shipments

Course Objectives

- Gain the competencies required to properly identify and handle shipments containing regulated goods for air transport according to the current edition of the relevant DGR, AVI, PER, ADR manuals. Understand the legal responsibilities involved with the transportation of dangerous goods.

Course Description

- This course will be presented with the use of handouts, slides, video's, practical exercises, group discussions and games.
- The course will finish with an open-book examination.

Prerequisites

- No previous DG knowledge is necessary as this course is suitable for beginners.
- The IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations and all course materials are presented in English.
- The classroom facilitation can be given in English, Danish or Swedish.

Duration

3 Days (24 hours)

Note: In house courses can be split into smaller sessions

Certificate and further training

A certificate is awarded upon successful completion of the course and scoring a minimum of 80% in the final exam.
