Target Audience

Cargo terminal staff that handle cargo (including dangerous goods)

Course Objectives

This course will provide cargo terminal workers with the knowledge and skills to:

- Understand what hazardous substances are and the risk associated with them in an incident,
- Recognize the presence of hazardous substances in an emergency,
- Understand the role of the emergency responder at the Awareness level, including site security and control,
- Have understanding of the Transportation Emergency Response Guidebook,
- Realize the need for additional resources, call for appropriate assistance, and to make appropriate notifications to the community.

Course Description

- This is an interactive and practical course.
- This course will be presented with the use of handouts, slides, video's, practical exercises, group discussions and games.
- The course will finish with an open-book examination.

Prerequisites

- **IATA or ADR awareness course or higher.**
- The IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations and all course materials are presented in English.
- The classroom facilitation can be given in English, Danish or Swedish.

Course Duration

1 Day consisting of:

½ day classroom based

½ day undertaking practical exercises

Learning Outcomes

- **Detailed knowledge of site specific Emergency procedures**
- **Hidden dangerous goods**
- **Security Provision**

Certificate and further training

A certificate is awarded upon successful completion of the course and scoring a minimum of 80% in the final exam.

In order to keep this certificate validated, recurrent training must be provided within 24 months of the previous course. This also ensures knowledge is up-to-date.
