Course Objectives

- Gain the competencies required to properly identify and handle shipments containing dangerous goods for air transport according to the current edition of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) manual.
- Understand the legal responsibilities involved with the transportation of dangerous goods.

Course Description

- This course will be presented with the use of handouts, slides, video's, practical exercises, group discussions and games.
- The course will finish with an open-book examination.

Prerequisites

- Previous DG knowledge is not required as this course is suitable for beginners.
- The IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations and all course materials are presented in English.
- The classroom facilitation can be given in English, Danish or Swedish.
