Lithium Battery Awareness

Target Audience

Shippers & cargo handling personnel involved in the transport of “small” lithium batteries.

Course Objectives

- Gain the competencies required to properly identify, classify and handle shipments containing lithium batteries for air transport according to the current edition of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) manual.
- Understand the legal responsibilities involved with the transportation of dangerous goods.

This course only covers Section II lithium batteries.

Course Description

- This course will be presented with the use of handouts, slides, video's, practical exercises, group discussions and games.
- The course will finish with an open-book examination.

Prerequisites

- No previous DG knowledge is necessary as this course is suitable for beginners.
- The IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations and all course materials are presented in English.
- The classroom facilitation can be given in English, Danish or Swedish.

Duration

1 Day (1 hours)

Learning Outcomes

- **General philosophy.** Battery & IATA knowledge
- **Classification:** What different kinds of Batteries are there?
- **Packing:** How to properly package a Sec II LiBa shipment
- **Marking/Labeling:** How to correctly mark and label a Sec II LiBa shipment
- **Emergency procedures**
- **Work instructions** in compliance with IATA DGR 1.6
- **Security Provision**

Certificate and further training

A certificate is awarded upon successful completion of the course and scoring a minimum of 80% in the final exam.

In order to keep this certificate validated, recurrent training must be provided within 24 months of the previous course. This also ensures knowledge is up-to-date.
