
ICAO/IATA DGR Cat 1,2,3 - LiBa SHIPPER COURSE

Target Audience

Shippers of all types of Lithium Batteries.

Course Objectives

- Gain the competencies required to properly identify, classify and prepare shipments containing lithium batteries for air and road transport according to the current edition of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) manual and ADR (Road DG regulations).
- Understand the legal responsibilities involved with the transportation of dangerous goods.

Course Description

- This course will be presented with the use of handouts, slides, video's, practical exercises, group discussions and games.
- The course will finish with an open-book examination.

Prerequisites

- No previous DG knowledge is necessary as this course is suitable for beginners.
- The IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations and all course materials are presented in English.
- The classroom facilitation can be given in English, Danish or Swedish.

Duration

2 Days (16 hours)

Learning Outcomes

- Understand the basis and applicability of the IATA DGR and ADR
- Understand the limitations and apply the states and operation variations
- Identify the 9 hazard classes
- Apply the applicable special provisions
- Apply the provisions for packing, marking and labelling of dangerous goods shipments
- Complete the transport documentation (dangerous goods documentation and air waybill - AWB) and any other accompanied documents
- State the relevant emergency response and reporting procedure
- Security provisions

Certificate and further training

A certificate is awarded upon successful completion of the course and scoring a minimum of 80% in the final exam.

In order to keep this certificate validated, recurrent training must be provided within 24 months of the previous course. This also ensures knowledge is up-to-date.
